### **TEFAT pre-opening tests**

Remain the same as for the June phased reopening

- 1. The school site is compliant with Health and Safety legislation and can be maintained to a high standard of cleanliness once opened
- 2. There are appropriate staff (in number and type) available for work to ensure the safety and well-being of the children on site and those learning from home
- 3. There is an adequate supply of PPE for those staff required to support a pupil or staff member showing symptoms whilst on site or those carrying out intimate care

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4. Minimising contact and mixing between individuals alongside maintaining social distancing wherever possible has been considered. It is reasonable to assume that social distancing can be maintained so far as is reasonably practical by the number of staff, pupils and parents on site at any time
